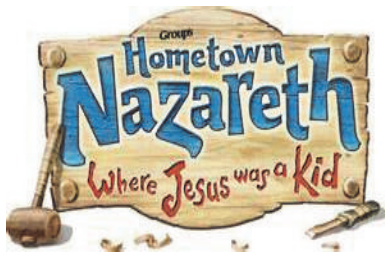

## Youth Ministry

### Middle School Youth Ministry

Our Monday afternoon meetings for 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> graders are **on break until the Fall**. Our Parent/Student Orientation meeting is scheduled for Monday, Sept. 14<sup>th</sup> at 7pm in the church, and our first class for the students will be Monday, Sept. 21<sup>st</sup> from 4:30-6:00pm. We will be participating in a regional **Summer Madness** program this summer from July 20<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup>. It is an opportunity for Middle School students (current 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders in the 2014/2015 school year) to take part in service activities, meet students from other parishes (make new friends), and have fun. Each day (Monday - Thursday) the students will go to a different service site in the morning and help serve. They will return for lunch together, and then we'll all go have fun in the afternoon (bowling, laser-tag, skating, etc.). On Friday, July 24<sup>th</sup>, we'll all go to Hershey Park for the day (the Hershey Park trip is **ONLY** open to students who are participating in Summer Madness). **Deadline has passed.** Please keep us in your prayers that week.

### High School Youth Ministry

Our Sunday evening faith formation meetings are on break until the Fall. The tentative calendar for the year can be found on the parish website. While our Sunday evening meetings are on break until the Fall, our **Wednesday Night meetings run all through the summer**. We even have a new format for the Wed. Finally, again this summer we are sending a team out for our **Work Camp trip**. Our team will be joining many other students from parishes around the Archdiocese of Baltimore to perform "Habitat for Humanity" type work for the week. **The expenses for the Appalachia trip are \$350 per person. We're asking the students to pay for part of their expenses (\$175), and we're hoping parishioners will consider sponsoring students for the remainder of their expenses (\$175 per student, although partial sponsorship is also welcome). We have asked this of you in years past, and you have supported us amazingly; we are grateful! We know things are tight in this economy, but this is a worthwhile investment!
