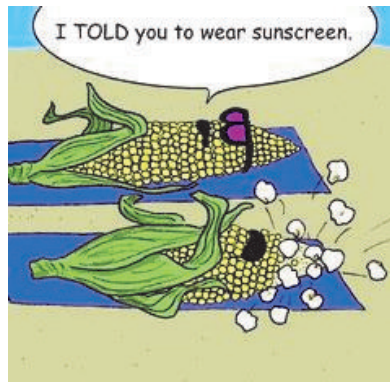

### **Middle School Youth Ministry**

Our Monday afternoon meetings for 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> graders are **on break until the Fall**. Our Parent/Student Orientation meeting is scheduled for Monday, Sept. 19<sup>th</sup> at 7pm in the church, and our first class for the students will be Monday, Sept. 26<sup>th</sup> from 4:30-6:00pm. We will be participating in a regional **Summer Madness** program this summer from July 25<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup>. It is an opportunity for Middle School students (current 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders in the 2015/2016 school year) to take part in service activities, meet students from other parishes (make new friends), and have fun. Each day (Monday - Thursday) the students will go to a different service site in the morning and help serve. They will return for lunch together, and then we'll all go have fun in the afternoon (bowling, laser-tag, mini-golf, etc.). On Friday, July 29<sup>th</sup>, we'll all go to Hershey Park for the day (the Hershey Park trip is **ONLY** open to students who are participating in Summer Madness).
