What is the House of Hope?

The Arundel House of Hope, Inc. is a non-profit 501 C(3) ecumenical organization dedicated to providing support services for the homeless of our community. Founded in 1992 by James Fouse, Arundel House of Hope began as a community movement, supported by local churches and volunteers, to address the issue of homelessness. Over the past twenty-two years, Arundel House of Hope has grown to encompass program offerings in several areas, addressing the needs of men, women and families experiencing homelessness in Anne Arundel County. It strives to counsel, guide and assist these people to become independent, improving the quality of life for them and the community. Currently, the Arundel House of Hope is supported by about sixty local churches and organizations and over 2,000 volunteers.

Through the inception of the Winter Relief Program, a rotating weekly shelter runs from November to April, with the host organizations working with the homeless, by providing temporary shelter, meals, clothing and other support services. It annually serves many men and women who are experiencing homelessness.

Our Lady of the Chesapeake has been a host site since 2006, and for a week in January, shelters 35-40 people each night.
