### **YOU'VE HEARD OF "CHRIST LIFE" -----NOW HERE IT IS---- REVEALED AND UNVEILED----IN ITS FULL SPLENDOR**

We hope you have enjoyed the Splash of Pentecost in your life and the outpouring of God's Spirit. Think back to how He /She "blew into" into your life. Did you notice or did you miss Him / Her'? We frequently do miss The Presence!. Most of us need a friend or bud to help distinguish the true Sprit from wishful thinking, or an itch; you know! CHRIST LIFE invites people like most of us who need a little direction and a boost in detecting this movements of God's Spirit in our lives. 

## Youth Ministry

As a matter of fact, he celebrated the first Confirmation at Our Lady of the Chesapeake 29 years ago too. It was great to have him back with us. We had 36 wonderful students who fully joined our family and it was a great celebration. Please continue to keep them in your prayers.

Thank you to everyone who helped with the liturgical celebration (music ministry, ushers, altar servers, Eucharistic Ministers, Deacon Rick, and Fr. Raff), and everyone who helped with the Pot-Luck dinner in the hall afterwards. And a special thanks to Gina Degreenia who coordinated the Pot-Luck dinner, and her whole family who helped to clean up afterwards!

### Middle School Youth Ministry

Our Monday afternoon meetings for 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> graders are **on break until the Fall**. Our Parent/Student Orientation meeting is scheduled for Monday, Sept. 14<sup>th</sup> at 7pm in the church, and our first class for the students will be Monday, Sept. 21<sup>st</sup> from 4:30-6:00pm.

We will be participating in a regional **Summer Madness** program this summer from July 20<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup>. It is an opportunity for Middle School students (current 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders in the 2014/2015 school year) to take part in service activities, meet students from other parishes (make new friends), and have fun. Each day (Monday - Thursday) the students will go to a different service site in the morning and help serve. They will return for lunch together, and then we'll all go have fun in the afternoon (bowling, laser-tag, skating, etc.). On Friday, July 24<sup>th</sup>, we'll all go to Hershey Park for the day (the Hershey Park trip is ONLY open to students who are participating in Summer Madness). Summer Madness can not happen without parents helping (Child Protection trained and cleared parents). Flyers with more details and permission forms have been e-mailed to parents, and are also available in the box on the Business Office door in the church lobby. Space is limited, and is first come, first serve. **Deadline is fast approaching!**

### High School Youth Ministry

While our Sunday evening meetings have ended until the Fall, our **Wednesday Night meetings run all through the summer**. We even have a new format for the Wed. Night Group (see below), and encourage all our high school to come and join us! AND...keep your eyes peeled for a listing of our **Summer Events!**

We went to **Hershey Park** on Saturday, May 30<sup>th</sup>...11 students and 2 adults, and we had a great day. While it was hot, there was no rain and the students enjoyed many rides. A special thank you to John Kuruc who chaperoned and helped make the trip possible for all the students.

Finally, again this summer we are sending a team out for our **Work Camp trip**. We were not able to pull together a Baltimore Team this year so we are sending one team to Terra Alta, West Virginia (June 28-July 4). Our OLC Team consists of 9 students and 2 adults. Our team will be joining many other students from parishes around the Archdiocese of Baltimore to perform "Habitat for Humanity" type work for the week. **The expenses for the Appalachia trip is \$350 per person. We're asking the students to pay for part of their expenses (\$175), and we're hoping parishioners will consider sponsoring students for the remainder of their expenses (\$175 per student, although partial sponsorship is also welcome). We have asked this of you in years past, and you have supported us amazingly; we are grateful!** We know things are tight in this economy, but this is a worthwhile investment!
