### Middle School Youth Ministry

Our Monday afternoon meetings for 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> graders are **on break until the Fall**. As soon as next year's calendar is available, we'll let you know of start dates.

We will be participating in a regional **Summer Madness** program this summer from July 25<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup>. It is an opportunity for Middle School students (current 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> graders in the 2015/2016 school year) to take part in service activities, meet students from other parishes (make new friends), and have fun. Each day (Monday - Thursday) the students will go to a different service site in the morning and help serve. They will return for lunch together, and then we'll all go have fun in the afternoon (bowling, laser-tag, mini-golf, etc.). On Friday, July 29<sup>th</sup>, we'll all go to Hershey Park for the day (the Hershey Park trip is ONLY open to students who are participating in Summer Madness). Summer Madness can not happen without parents helping (Child Protection trained and cleared parents). Flyers with more details and permission forms have been e-mailed to parents, and are also available in the box on the Business Office door in the church lobby. Space is limited, and is first come, first serve.

### High School Youth Ministry

While our Sunday evening meetings have ended until the Fall, our **Wednesday Night meetings run all through the summer** (see below), and we encourage all our high school students to come and join us! AND...keep your eyes peeled for a listing of our **Summer Events!**

Our **Spring Retreat** was April 29<sup>th</sup> - May 1<sup>st</sup>. 55 of us went to Camp Letts in Edgewater, MD and our theme was "Pathways." We reflected on our past (from babyhood through childhood), and the present (young adulthood), and then into the future...all the while focusing on the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation), and how God is not just present to us at certain moments, but He has our backs all throughout our lives. Responding to Jesus' call to be missionary disciples is not just a little sacrifice, but a life-altering decision that changes everything...and it is so worth it! We worked together, played together, and worshiped together. Fr. Raff even came out Sunday morning and celebrated Mass with us. Thanks for all your prayers.

The Archdiocese's Mission Office is sponsoring the annual **Haiti Trip** for students aged 16-20 on July 10-16. Students spend a week in Haiti running a day camp for younger Haitian students at a school in St. Marc. Deadline for submitting applications to the Archdiocese has passed. We have 5 students applying...we'll keep you posted on their acceptance.

Finally, again this summer we are sending teams out for our **Work Camp trips**. One team will be heading into Baltimore City (June 19-25), and one team will be going to Terra Alta, West Virginia (June 26-July 2); teams from OLC consist of at least 5 students and 2 adults. Our teams will be joining many other students from parishes around the Archdiocese of Baltimore to perform "Habitat for Humanity" type work for the week. The deadline for applying has past. **The expenses for the Baltimore and Appalachia trips are \$350 per person. For both work camp trips, we're asking the students to pay for part of their expenses (\$175), and we're hoping parishioners will consider sponsoring students for the remainder of their expenses (\$175 per student, although partial sponsorship is also welcome). We have asked this of you in years past, and you have supported us amazingly; we are grateful! We know things are tight in this economy, but this is a worthwhile investment!
